

New Jersey League for Nursing Nursing Scholarship Criteria

Application Requirements for a Scholarship

- The applicant must:
 - Be a legal resident of the United States.
 - Be a permanent in-state resident of New Jersey.
 - Be enrolled in an accredited nursing program within the state of New Jersey.
 - Have completed one of the following:
 - One clinical course in a nursing program that prepares graduates for practice as a registered nurse (Diploma, ADN, BSN).
 - One semester in an accredited nursing program. (MSN, Doctorate).
- Evidence of academic ability:
 - Transcripts from the institution currently enrolled (must include the most recent semester completed).
 - Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or greater.
- Complete the New Jersey League for Nursing (NJLN) 2017 Scholarship Application form.
- Provide one written character reference from a current or previous nursing professor.
- Submit an essay explaining how you plan to advance the health of the patients, families or communities where you will be practicing.

- All applications and supporting documents must be received in the New Jersey League for Nursing office by Tuesday September 15, 2017.
